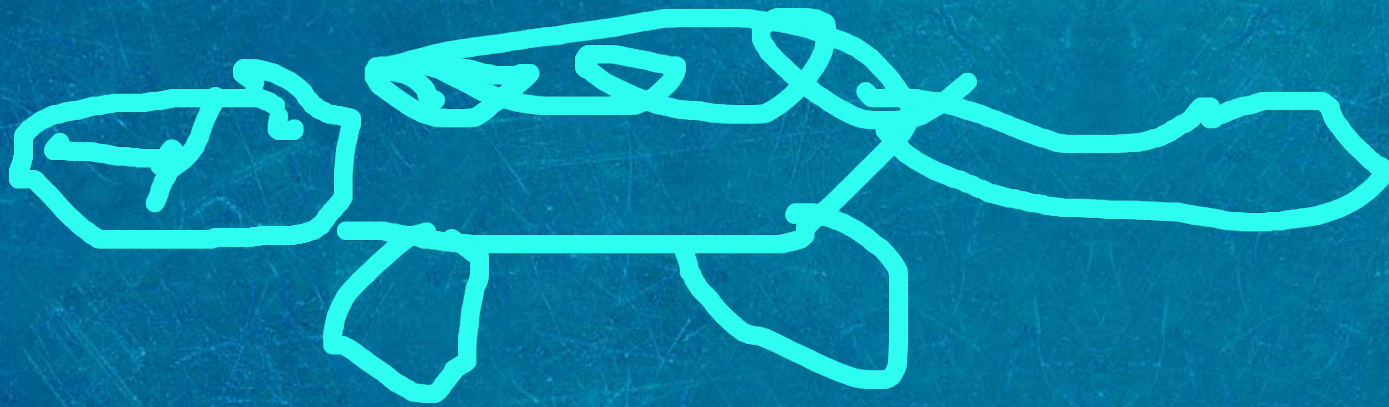
Herbivore Dragons

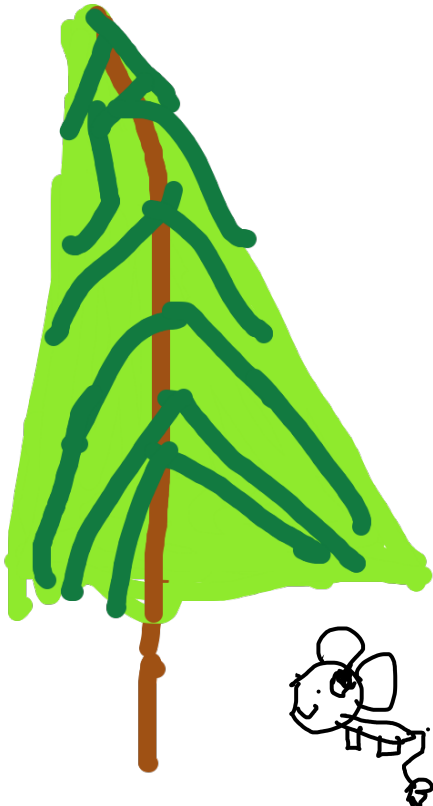
Sea Dragon
